Avoid names, birthdays, or anything someone could find on social media.

COMBINE THEM INTO A SINGLE PASSPHRASE

Something like
"OrangeNotebook12Elephants"
is long, random, and
surprisingly easy to remember.

USE A DIFFERENT PASSWORD FOR EVERY ACCOUNT

If one account is compromised, attackers will try the same password everywhere else.

ENABLE MFA ON ALL CRITICAL ACCOUNTS

Multi-factor authentication adds a second layer of security.



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
